


New Keyword "Priming"

- A new Keyword ability that will be included starting with the "Hidden Legends" set. By "Priming" the *Job Dominant* card, it can transform into a *Job Eikon* card.
- By paying the cost (Priming cost) listed in the Keyword you, can use "Priming." Priming cost can be paid only during your main phase when the stack is empty.
- When the Priming cost is paid, one Character card with the name that is listed in the Keyword will be searched from the deck, then placed on top of the Priming card.
- "Priming" effects cannot be placed on the Stack. When the Priming cost is paid, you will immediately search the relevant card.



The state of being Primed 1

- When there are 2 cards stacked due to Priming, it is called being "Primed" [or in a "Primed" state].
- A Primed card is treated as a single Character.
- A Primed card possesses both names of each card.
- Information other than the card name such as cost, job, card text, and power, will only be of the card *Job Eikon* that is on top.

"Primed State"

Card name: *Clive/Ifrit (XVI)*



Cannot be placed in the field!



If the two characters are not in a Primed state, both can be controlled.

*Clive may not be "Primed" in this situation.





The state of being Primed 2

- A Primed card will maintain any effects or damage it has received, as well as the state that it is in before Priming.

Example;

1. A dull card that is Primed will become Primed while maintaining its Dull state.
2. A Primed card may not attack in the same turn it has been placed in the field unless it has Haste.
3. A card that received a power gain/loss or abilities will maintain that effect after getting Primed.



The state of being Primed 3

- When the two cards are removed from the field, both cards will be moved to the designated zone, then after which the top card *Job Eikon* will be immediately removed from the game. The bottom card *Job Dominant* will remain in the designated zone.
