

"Priming" Supplementary Explanation 1

1. Despite a card being Primed, a searched card is not in the field. Therefore, an auto-ability that requires a Forward to enter the field, like Mira [20-102L]'s auto-ability, does not trigger.
2. You can discard either card to pay for the special ability of a Primed Character.

Does not trigger an auto-ability



Cost remains the same



Special ability can be used by discarding *Clive*



"Priming" Supplementary Explanation 2

- Effects that reference information about cards that have moved from the field, such as Leviathan [19-101R], only reference the information of the card on top.
- A Primed card is treated as a single Character. Therefore, even if a Character in a Primed state is removed from the field, an auto-ability that requires a Character to leave the field, such as Leviathan, Lord of the Whorl [14-102L], will only trigger once.

Clive can be cast immediately

A cost 8 forward can be played
**A cost 5 forward cannot be played*

Auto-ability triggers only once



"Priming" Supplementary Explanation 3

5. "Priming" will cause a card to be searched. When you activate Priming to search for a card, auto-abilities triggered on the condition that a card is searched, such as Remedi [13-034H]'s auto-ability, are triggered. Furthermore, a card is not considered Primed until the required card is searched and put in a Primed state.
6. Even if the power value was changed by cards like Diabolos [6-052R] before Priming, when in the Primed state the power will be changed to that of the stacked *Job Eikon*.
